RENEWAL OF INSOLVENCY PRACTITIONERS' LICENSES

The Office of the Registrar of Companies (ORC), acting in its regulatory capacity under **Sections 153(3)(a)** and **161(1)** of the Corporate Insolvency and Restructuring Act, 2020 (Act 1015), as amended by Act 1031, wishes to notify all licensed Insolvency Practitioners of the statutory requirement to renew their licenses annually.

Pursuant to the above provisions, the Registrar is mandated to register, regulate and maintain a comprehensive register of Insolvency Practitioners operating within the Republic of Ghana. **In fulfillment of this mandate, all currently licensed Insolvency Practitioners are required to renew their licenses on or before 28th November, 2025.**

Failure to comply with this requirement by the stated deadline may result in revocation of the practitioner's license.

A valid license is essential for practitioners to remain in good regulatory standing and to lawfully offer insolvency and restructuring services. The ORC therefore urges all licensed Insolvency Practitioners who have not yet completed the renewal process to do so promptly by visiting the Office of the Registrar of Companies.
