**NOTICE ON THE PUBLICATION OF THE COMPANIES BULLETIN**

The Office of the Registrar of Companies (ORC) wishes to inform the general public, business owners and company officers that, as part of its ongoing statutory mandate under Section 370 of the Companies Act, 2019 (Act 992), the Office will continue to publish statutory notices through the *Companies Bulletin*.

The *Companies Bulletin* serves as the official platform for the publication of statutory notices and other matters required under the Companies Act, 2019 (Act 992), in line with the Registrar's mandate to promote transparency, accountability and public access to corporate information.

Under the Act, the Registrar shall publish notices including, but not limited to:

- Change of company names – Sections 21(11) and 21(12)
- Publication of unclaimed dividends transferred to the Registrar – Section 73(8)
- Registration and publication of court orders and minutes – Section 81(1)
- Registration of enforcement of security – Section 119(6)
- Notices of registration of annual returns – Section 126(5)
- Orders restraining fraudulent persons from managing companies – Section 177(10)
- Court-approved arrangements or compromises – Section 239(11)
- Resolutions for liquidation and related procedures – Section 276(3)
- Appointment and removal of liquidators – Section 278(4)
- Stay of proceedings and related court orders – Sections 287(3) and 287(5)
- Dissolution and restoration of companies – Sections 288(1) and 288(4)
- Dissolution without full winding up – Sections 289(2), (3), (4), and (5)
- Conversion of private companies to public companies – Section 302(3)
- Registration of documents and alterations relating to external companies – Sections 330(2) and 331(4)
- Winding up and cessation of business of external companies – Sections 338(1)(c) and 340(1)
- Publication of fees payable – Section 371(2)
- Directives and guidelines issued by the Registrar – Section 382(2)

The ORC encourages companies, corporate bodies, legal practitioners and the general public to regularly consult the *Companies Bulletin* for statutory notices and regulatory updates relating to corporate activities in Ghana.

The ORC remains committed to promoting transparency, strengthening corporate governance, and ensuring an efficient regulatory environment for businesses operating in Ghana.
