**FINAL REMINDER: NO EXTENSION BEYOND 30TH JUNE 2026.**

The Office of the Registrar of Companies (ORC) wishes to issue this final reminder to all registered Business Owners, Company Directors, Secretaries, and Partners of Incorporated Partnerships in Ghana that, **there will be no extension beyond Tuesday, 30th June 2026 deadline for the filing of Annual Returns and the Renewal of Business Names.** This follows an earlier press release issued on 28<sup>th</sup> April 2026, which announced the said deadline and urged all defaulting Companies and Businesses to comply.

Companies who fail to file Annual Returns with financial statement shall be deemed non-compliant and would be liable to pay a **penalty of Two Thousand Ghana Cedis (GHc 2,000)** for companies that have **defaulted for five (5) years or more** and **One Thousand Ghana Cedis Only (GHc 1,000)** for companies that have **defaulted between one (1) and four (4) years** in addition to filing fees.

We therefore urge all companies and business owners to comply with these statutory obligations within the specified time frame to ensure continuity and avoid the risk of being delisted from the official Register.
